Appointment of Coach/Assessors

Round 1

Coach/assessors will be appointed on the recommendation of ACDS Coaching Panel. These coach/assessors will be appointed from the ranks of ACDS members who meet the following criteria:

- Extensive horsemanship skills
- Carriage driving experience
- Communication skills
- Coaching experience

The Federal Coaching Panel will invite those members considered suitable to be coach/assessors.

Invited Coach/assessors who accept the invitation will need to:

• Complete Beginning Coaching General Principles though the Australian Sports commission online at:

(Coach/assessors with coaching qualifications obtained through another equestrian or sporting association may be exempt from this requirement)

- Be prepared to mentor candidate coaches

Round 2


Coach/assessors will be appointed on the recommendation of ACDS Coaching Panel. These coach/assessors will be appointed from the ranks of ACDS Coaches who meet the following criteria:

- Completed the ACDS Coaching Scheme
- Conducted carriage driving clinics

Round 2 nominations will be considered by the Federal Coaching Panel at the Annual ACDS Federal Conference.

Removal from ACDS Coaches Panel

Coach/assessors and coaches may be removed from ACDS Coaching panel at the discretion of the ACDS Federal Coaching Panel following a unanimous vote of panel members.
