#### **SUNDAY 9 JUNE**

**Dressage:** Presentation on the move for all classes. Time for Dressage to commence will be advised.

**Cone Driving:** Conducted as a fault competition. May include a bridge.

Competitors are asked to move directly to the Cones Course on completion of their Dressage Test.

A Competitors Meeting re the Marathon will take place early evening at a time to be advised.

#### **Event Dinner at the Hall at 6pm**

#### **MONDAY 10 JUNE**

First Horse Inspection to commence at 7:30am Competitors are asked to present in order of starting times

**Marathon:** The course will be in three sections, not exceeding 16 kms in total.

There will be 7 Marathon Obstacles.

The countryside is mostly flat to slightly undulating on unsealed roads and firm bush tracks.

#### **PRIZES AND AWARDS**

Prize winners please be dressed in Presentation gear.

Rosettes to 4th place in all individual classes.

South Australian Branch of the ACDS Perpetual Trophies will be awarded.

#### CAMPING VENUE AND FACILITIES

Entry includes camping. Toilets, showers and water available but no powered camping sites.

#### **HORSES**

Yards are available on site at \$10 each for the duration of the event. Yards are to be booked and paid for with competition entry. Priority for the limited number of yards will be given to those who are travelling longer distances. There is a \$30 bond for yards booked which will be refunded when your yard is left clean, tidy and undamaged. If your yard is not left in the above condition, the bond will be retained by the Organising Committee.

Own yards may be erected and must be of solid steel construction in accordance with the By Laws of Southern Carriage Driving Society. **Electric wire or rope yards are not allowed**. All horses must be yarded in the designated equestrian area.

All horse manure must be collected and removed from the grounds. Bags are available from the Secretary's Office.

**Stallions** are required to display green "stallion" discs at all times, either on their halter or bridle in accordance with the SCDS Stallion Policy.

#### **CATERING**

Light refreshments are available for purchase during the day until 6 pm on Sunday and Monday or BYO food and refreshments.

Cook your own BBQ facilities will be available at the Hall on Friday and Saturday nights Pre-Order BBQ packs on Entry Form

An informal, catered dinner will be available off site on Monday night

#### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

This event will be judged under the Rules for Australian Carriage Driving Society Combined Driving Events effective 1st August 2018, and additional regulations as specified in this schedule.

- Drivers must be full members of the ACDS.
- Grading of horses is taken at the closing date of entries.
- The organisers reserve the right to:

Alter the advertised times:

Refuse any entry, with or without stating a reason;

Measure any horse or pony upon discretion;

Reallocate a competitor to the appropriate class;

Swab any horses/ponies.

② Appeals must be lodged with \$50.00, with the Event Secretary within 30 minutes of the scores of each phase being posted. Money will be refunded unless, in the opinion of the Appeals Committee, the appeal is found to be frivolous.

<sup>1</sup> The Australian Carriage Driving Society recommends the wearing of back protectors, suitable for equestrian use when on the marathon.

It is compulsory for all drivers and grooms to wear protective head gear, designed for equestrian use, in all sections of the marathon, as per the requirements of the ACDS CDE Rules. All Junior persons (being under 18 years of age) driving or riding in a carriage must wear protective head gear, complying with the standards stipulated on the signed entry form, AT ALL TIMES whilst at this event.

Entry fees are non-refundable after the commencement of the event. If a horse or driver is unable to attend due to illness or accident, an application for refund may be considered by the Organising Committee on production of a medical or veterinary certificate. 20% of entry fees will be retained for administration purposes.

② Non competing horses/ponies. Requests to bring a non competing horse or pony to the event venue must be made in writing to the Organising Committee prior to the closing date for entries, including reason for bringing horse or pony. Permission must be granted by the Organising Committee. For the duration of their stay at the venue they will not be permitted to be ridden, driven or lunged. They can only be walked on a lead.

2 The entire Marathon Course will be a Non Smoking Zone.
