Catering will be limited due to Covid Restrictions – tea, coffee and cool drinks for sale.

Organisers Rights: The organisers have the right to:

- Alter any advertised times
- Refuse an entry, with or without stating the reason
- Measure horses or ponies
- Reallocate a competitor to the appropriate class
- Penalise competitors for unsafe or cruel practices
- Combine Classes

Carriage Driving can be a dangerous sport and the organisers recommend that all drivers and grooms wear securely fastened protective headgear, suitable for equestrian purposes, during all phases of the competition.

Disclaimer:

All competitors compete at their own risk. The ACDS, Southern Carriage Driving Society, Murray Bridge Council and private property owners will not accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, equipment or property, owners, drivers, spectators, or any other person in connection with this event.

In accordance with the regulations as set down in the ACDES insurance, each ACDS member agrees to pay the excess which applies to any insurance claim.

Conditions of Entry

1. The event will be judged according to the Rules of the Australian Carriage Driving Society Combined Driving Events effective 15th October 2020, and additional regulations as specified in this schedule.
2. Drivers must be full ACDS financial members of an ACDS affiliated club.
3. Whenever helmets are worn for equine-related activities at ACDS events, they must comply with the current ACDS CDE Rules as of 1 January 2017. Competitors must make an assessment of the condition of any helmet/s used to ensure they meet the requirements (see acceptance declaration on entry form). **Helmets are compulsory for Marathon Section.**
4. All Junior Drivers aged between 12 & 16 must be accompanied by a Financial ACDS adult groom. Junior Grooms must be a minimum of 10 yrs for Singles & 14 yrs for Multiples and wear securely fastened protective headgear in accordance with Art 928.2.2.
5. Whenever a horse is harnessed to a vehicle, an ACDS member must be holding the reins.
6. Appeals are to be lodged in writing with the Event Secretary & accompanied by a payment of \$50.00. The appeal must be lodged within 30 minutes of the scores being officially posted. Money will be refunded unless, in the opinion of the Appeals Committee, the appeal is found to be frivolous.
7. All turnouts compete at their own risk. (See Disclaimer)
8. **Dogs are not encouraged at this event, but if brought, must remain on leash at all times. Owners must clean up after their dogs.**
9. Entries will not be accepted without nomination fee & a completed & signed entry form.
10. Any competitor late for a specified starting time, may be awarded time penalties and/or given a re-scheduled time.

I understand that as an ACDS Insurance requirement, where helmets are worn during carriage driving activities, they must comply with one or more of the specified Standards (AS/NZS3838;EN1384;ASTN F1163).

I confirm that I have conducted an assessment of the condition of my helmet/s & understand that it/they meet the requirement of AS/NZS3838 as a minimum.

I understand that if I am the driver of a carriage (or parent / guardian of a junior driver), it is my responsibility to confirm that any helmets worn by grooms or passengers (or junior driver) on that carriage also meet the requirements of AS/NZS3838 as a minimum.
