All Juniors up to 18 yo must wear an approved helmet at all times when in a Vehicle and under 10 yo Junior Driver must be accompanied by an adult ACDS member seated beside with second set of reins. The NSW ACDS, Boorowa Showground, Hill Tops Council take no responsibility for any loss or damage to competitors, volunteers, their equipment animals or support crew through the conducting of this event.

Event Details

- This Event has been planned by the NSW Branch of the ACDS to bring together all Disciplines of Carriage Driving
The NSW Branch will be covering the Cost of the Ground hire etc, so there is no Cost to be Charged to ACDS Members for Camping and Ground Expenses.
- Arrival - Grounds will be open from Saturday 9th April 2022. Please visit the Event Office upon arrival for directions to your camping area etc.
- Covid19 Safety-This event will be conducted under relevant Covid19 NSW Health Guidelines as in force at the time. QR code check-in may be required – please visit the Event Office upon arrival to check-in.
- Mini Enduro Competitor times and Schedule will be available from the Event Office from 1.00pm Sunday 10th April.
- Mini Enduro-the course will be running over 3 Days over paddocks, sealed and unsealed roads, with a maximum distance of 35 kms to 40 km. The countryside is mildly undulating. There are some sealed public road elements and all Drivers must obey NSW Road Rules at all Times.
- Competitors will not be able to drive motorised vehicles on the private property component of Section's or the Racetrack component of Boorowa Showground.
- It is recommended that horses / ponies are fit.
- TPR's Stewards will be on Ground to perform TRP Checking at the Completion of the Enduro's as defined in the ACDS Guidelines for TPR and Endurance Driving.
- Junior Drivers on Carriages or any person on a carriage who is under 18 years of age must wear protective headgear in accordance with ACDS by-laws.
- Bicycles, Powered Mobility aids etc Bicycles, both push and electric, may be used on the grounds however helmet requirements apply as it is public space. Powered mobility aids may be used in accordance with provisions in ACDS Rules.
- All users of bicycles and powered mobility aids must be mindful of their potential impact on horses and operate these items safely and with respect for others. These items are not permitted in or immediately adjacent to the Horse Yards area during Start Finish Point of Enduro.
- Awards-Trophies and ribbons / rosettes will be awarded. The organisers take no responsibility for the loss of awards and/or prizes if recipients do not remain for the award ceremony at the conclusion of the event. Place getters are expected to be appropriately dressed for awards ceremonies.

- Catering Breakfast will be available on site during the event with a breakfast menu, hot and cold drinks. (Days of operation TBC)
- Boorowa has multiple options for meals including Clubs, Pubs and Cafes.
- **Camping There are a limited number of powered sites available (horses must be yarded elsewhere) - please indicate on entry form if you require a powered site.**

- Subject to fire restrictions at the time, there will be a communal fire pit available for socialising. Individual campfires are permitted if they are in a raised fire pit and a suitable fire extinguisher is immediately available.
- Generators if used should be silenced-type and switched off at 10pm
- Showers & Toilets, including accessible facilities, are available at the Showground.
- Accommodation for those not intending to camp, there are two motels and a caravan park in Boorowa, Ned Ryan Motel: (02) 6227 2826, Blue Metal Motel: (02) 6385 3186 Boorowa Caravan Park: (02) 6385 3658.
However due to long-weekend, accommodation availability in Boorowa will be very limited.
- Dogs are allowed but **MUST** be kept on a leash at all times. You are expected to clean up after your dogs. The Showgrounds is Council-controlled space and penalties may apply for unrestrained dogs.
- **Horse Yards**
(Very important – please note!) A quantity of open steel yards are available at no cost - Yards must be requested on entry form (yards will be allocated on a 1st-in 1st-served basis) however, the majority of these yards have a concrete base, therefore it is recommended that you make arrangements for suitable bedding for your equine if using these yards.
- Secure portable solid yards are permitted in designated areas - Yards must be secured effectively to prevent them moving,
- Yards are not allowed in the Main Camping Area near the Grandstand/Hall.
- Electric fence yards are permitted in designated areas – yards must consist of two (2) strands of tape minimum and must be energised when containing equines.
- Manure to be placed in designated locations.
- Local Shops Boorowa local shopping options – IGA Supermarket, Cafes, Pubs, Clubs, Hardware, Petrol - however as it is a long weekend some services may not be available.
- Produce supplies Lucerne and Ryegrass hay will be available to purchase on the grounds – please contact Graeme Dowling 0408 487 067.
- Other feed & bedding supplies are available from Thompsons Rural Supplies - 02 6385 3624 and can be delivered to grounds by prior arrangement.
- Other Community Activities Boorowa is usually very busy on Easter weekend, with increased numbers of visitors and traffic to the town, and the resulting demand on services; however, it is also a great opportunity to promote carriage driving.
- It is hoped that this event will attract a number of spectators and we trust that competitors will help us to display carriage driving in the best possible light.
