## GENERAL INFORMATION

- Dress/Attire:** Presentation is not scored at Graded Driven Dressage Championships however a more formal attire is expected. Approved safety helmets and body protectors may be worn.
- Champion:** There will be a Champion at each Graded level.
- Awards:** Sashes or Rosettes will be awarded to 3rd place overall in each Class. Champion Rosette will be awarded at each level.
- Camping:** Is available – power / showers / toilets
- Yards:** A quantity of open steel yards are available at no cost - Yards must be requested on entry form (yards will be allocated on a 1st-in 1st-served basis).  
**However, the majority of these yards have a concrete base**, therefore it is recommended that you make arrangements for suitable bedding for your equine if using these yards. Secure portable solid yards are permitted in designated areas. Yards must be secured effectively to prevent them moving. Electric fence yards are permitted in designated areas – yards must consist of two (2) strands of tape minimum and must be **energised** when containing equines. Manure to be placed in designated locations.
- Dogs:** Dogs are allowed however must be restrained/controlled at ALL times.  
**No dogs are permitted on the Main Oval/Arena.** Any dog owner that does not abide by these rules will be asked to leave the venue.  
(Entry money will not be refunded).

# 2022 NSW GRADED DRIVEN DRESSAGE CHAMPIONSHIPS

## Conditions of Entry

1. This event will be conducted according to the current ACDS Graded Driven Dressage Rule Book and Guidelines dated 1 January, (Version V2.1 January 1, 2021) including State variations.
2. All competitors must be members of the ACDS. All judges must be selected from the ACDS judges' list, one of whom must be an Advanced Judge.
3. **Qualification details for these championships must be listed on the Entry Form.** All horse/s must be ACDS registered. To qualify drivers must have competed and completed two (2) Graded Driven Dressage Qualifiers each consisting of two (2) tests as listed at the horse's graded level or one (1) test at the horse's graded level and one (1) test at the level immediately above in 2022, the current season.
4. At State GDD Championships each horse will compete in two (2) tests, as listed in the schedule. Horse/s may only compete at the Championship at their graded level. Multiples will be graded per each combination. Grading is taken at the closing date of entries. Drivers should check the ACDS National GDD Grading List to ensure that the horse/s is entered at the correct level. <https://www.australiancarriagedrivingsociety.org>
5. Singles and Multiples will have separate classes at each level.
6. Subject to OC approval, competitors may drive more than one combination in the same class.
7. Presentation is not scored at GDD Championships however, a whip is compulsory and a more formal attire is expected. Drivers and Grooms under 18 MUST wear an approved helmet. Safety helmets and body protectors may be worn.
8. Grooms are optional for adult drivers in single graded driven dressage classes. Pairs and tandems – one (1) groom, four-in-hand – two (2) grooms. Grooms for singles must be 10 years or over and grooms for multiples 14 years and over.
9. Junior Drivers – as per the current ACDS By-Laws. Junior drivers aged 6-7 inclusive must be accompanied in the vehicle by an ACDS adult member (an experienced driving person) seated beside the driver and holding a second pair of reins attached to the bit. Junior drivers aged 8-15 years inclusive must be accompanied in the vehicle by an ACDS adult member (an experienced driving person) who must be facing forward. Junior Drivers under 18 are not allowed to drive stallions at ACDS events. Junior Multiple Drivers aged 16-17 years inclusive may drive a tandem or pair or team of ponies and they must be accompanied in the vehicle by an ACDS adult member (an experienced driving person).
10. Safety Rules must be adhered to.
11. Helmets are not compulsory in GDD, other than for Drivers and Grooms under the age of 18. Helmets must comply with the current ACDS By-Law. For all other drivers, grooms, safety helmets and body protectors may be worn.
12. It is the responsibility of each competitor to inspect their vehicle and equipment to ensure that it is safe to proceed with the day's activities. All drivers and grooms compete at their own risk.
13. The Organisers have the right to alter any advertised times, refuse any entry with or without stating the reason, or re-allocate a horse or pony to the appropriate class.
14. Only horses on the entry form are permitted to attend, unless prior approval has been received from the OC.
15. **Parents or guardians are responsible for their children at this event.**
